

#### **DIVING**

For experienced divers, embark on your own dive trips within the encircling reef and beyond. Inner reef excursions are possible at any time, preferrably rising tide. All our sites are within a 45-minute boat journey and our remoteness very rarely means you will encounter another dive boat.

Inner Reef – Fun Dives	
Outer Reef – White Wall (minimum 2 persons)	US\$600 per person

#### **COURSES AND CERTIFICATION**

We offer PADI dive instruction for all levels, including Bubblemaker (8 to 9 years old), Junior Open Water and PADI specialty courses. The duration of a PADI-certification course depends on whether the guest has completed their dive theory at home (recommended). Generally, a complete beginner can be certified at COMO Laucala Island in four days, with any refresher instruction done free of charge. Please note no dives can take place within 24 hours of air travel.

#### **KAYAKING**



#### **SNORKELLING**

Snorkelling sites are just a swim out from your Residence — the Seagrass area, for instance, is a fabulous fish nursery. To get the best experience possible, we encourage guests to ask for a guided excursion.

#### **TENNIS**

#### **FARM TOUR**

Immerse yourself in COMO Laucala Island's farm-to-table philosophy with an in-depth tour of the island's food resources. A guide will take you by vehicle through our herb garden, flower garden, and orchard. Then, you will be taken to the nursery facility to see a variety of different types of fruits, vegetables, citrus trees and orchids. The tour continues to the other side of the island, along ocean views and dense jungle, to the farm animals and horse stables. This activity is complimentary.





#### **HIKING**

#### Tavoro Falls, Taveuni

A 30-minute boat ride to Taveuni is followed by a three-and-a-half hour hike to three spectacular waterfalls in Bouma National Park. The first waterfall is 24 metres tall, while the middle has a 15 metres drop. The upper waterfall cascades 10m into a jade green natural swimming pool. Be prepared for some slippery rocks, muddy shoes, and rope-guided river crossings.


#### **COMO Laucala Island Trails**

We have three complimentary hikes on marked paths, which you can do with a guide:

- Advanced Summit Hike (two hours): Loops up to the highest point on a marked path.
- Intermediate Tower Hike (one hour): Spectacular westward views
- Intermediate Round-the-Island Hike (four hours): Follows the coastal path, with the sea nearly always in view. Various lookouts for rest and picnics are positioned en route, and complimentary guiding is always available.

#### MOUNTAIN BIKING

Mountain bikes for adults and children: Take a bike to ride around the resort. For the more adventurous, explore the island with a challenging ride all the way around the island (two hours)

Our magnificent mixed mountain biking trail is not for the faint-hearted. This route follows the island's coastline, incorporating steep inclines and free-wheeling downhills on cobble, gravel, grass, and hard sand, with the topography changing from beachside avenues of palms, to eerie mangroves, thick primary forest, and grassy paths flanked by Banyan trees cascading over black basalt rocks.

Top riders should be able to complete the island circuit in just over an hour; the 'jogging fit' will take closer to two. Those who wish to take a more leisurely pace can make the most of the spectacular scenery with a set-up picnic on the way. This activity is always guided, and is complimentary.

#### **HORSE RIDING**

Whether you are an experienced rider or have never touched a saddle in your life, our guide can take you on an enjoyable ride on horses. Ride through the coconut plantation and along the beaches on the resort side, before a quiet picnic lunch on the beach or at the stable bar.

Our horses are crossbreeds of Australian Thoroughbreds (bred for the Melbourne race track) and British Clydesdales (used for the plantations). Equestrians can go out on hacks around the island, canter 'Long Beach' at low tide, and swim bareback in the ocean. The stables are looked after by our resident 'Horse Whisperer,' who also guides guests and provides tuition in an enclosed riding arena. Closed-toe shoes are required, and the minimum guest age is eight. This activity is complimentary.

#### FITNESS CENTRE

#### **GOLF**

The 18-hole Championship Course is carefully set in the old plantation, surrounded by Laucala's dramatic mountains. Designed by Scotsman David McLay Kidd, this par-72 course is challenging for experienced players, but with a variety of tee box options, is also inviting to those new to the game. The par-5 12th hole is the signature hole: the green extends on to the beach. Any number of games is complimentary. Games include access to the driving range and putting green, as well as the use of golf clubs and buggies. For lessons with a golf professional, please let us know in advance of your stay.
