AT COMO MAALIFUSHI

Transfers

Guests of COMO Maalifushi in the Maldives will be taken to our resort via a 60-minute seaplane transfer from Malé International Airport. These transfers utilise 15-seat, twin propeller planes which fly at a much lower altitude than conventional jet planes. The flight is therefore closer to a sight-seeing experience, giving guests spectacular aerial views of the archipelago before their arrival at our seaplane platform – five minutes away from the resort by speedboat. Occasionally the seaplane may make scheduled stops at other resorts which might increase the overall transfer time. We also arrange diverted seaplane transfers for guests who have booked a stay at COMO Cocoa Island (refer to Late Departures for pricing).

COMO Maalifushi staff will meet guests in the international airport's arrivals hall and be on hand to assist them. Guests are welcome to use the Manta Air VIP lounge with Wi-Fi, satellite television, shower facilities, snacks and drinks.

Seaplane Transfer Schedule

Guests should contact COMO Maalifushi at least 72 hours before their arrival time into Malé International so we can book them onto the next available seaplane transfer. Government regulations mean that our seaplanes' final take-off is at 4.30pm each day (arrivals after 3.30pm will therefore need to book a hotel at the airport for a night).

Prices

A return seaplane transfer to COMO Maalifushi is priced at US\$890 per adult, and US\$445 per child (aged between two and 11). Infants younger than two years old are free of charge. This includes carriage for luggage of up to 25kg per person. A private seaplane, seating up to 10 people, can be arranged and is priced at US\$8,000 one-way.

Prices above are nett; they include prevailing government taxes.

Late Departures

Guests with a late departure time on their homeward flight from Malé International Airport are invited to take the last seaplane (around 3.30pm) from COMO Maalifushi, direct to our sister resort, COMO Cocoa Island, for a diversion fee of US\$560 per trip. Here, they can enjoy a day visit that includes a two-course meal in Ufaa restaurant and a speedboat transfer to the airport for US\$450 per person.
