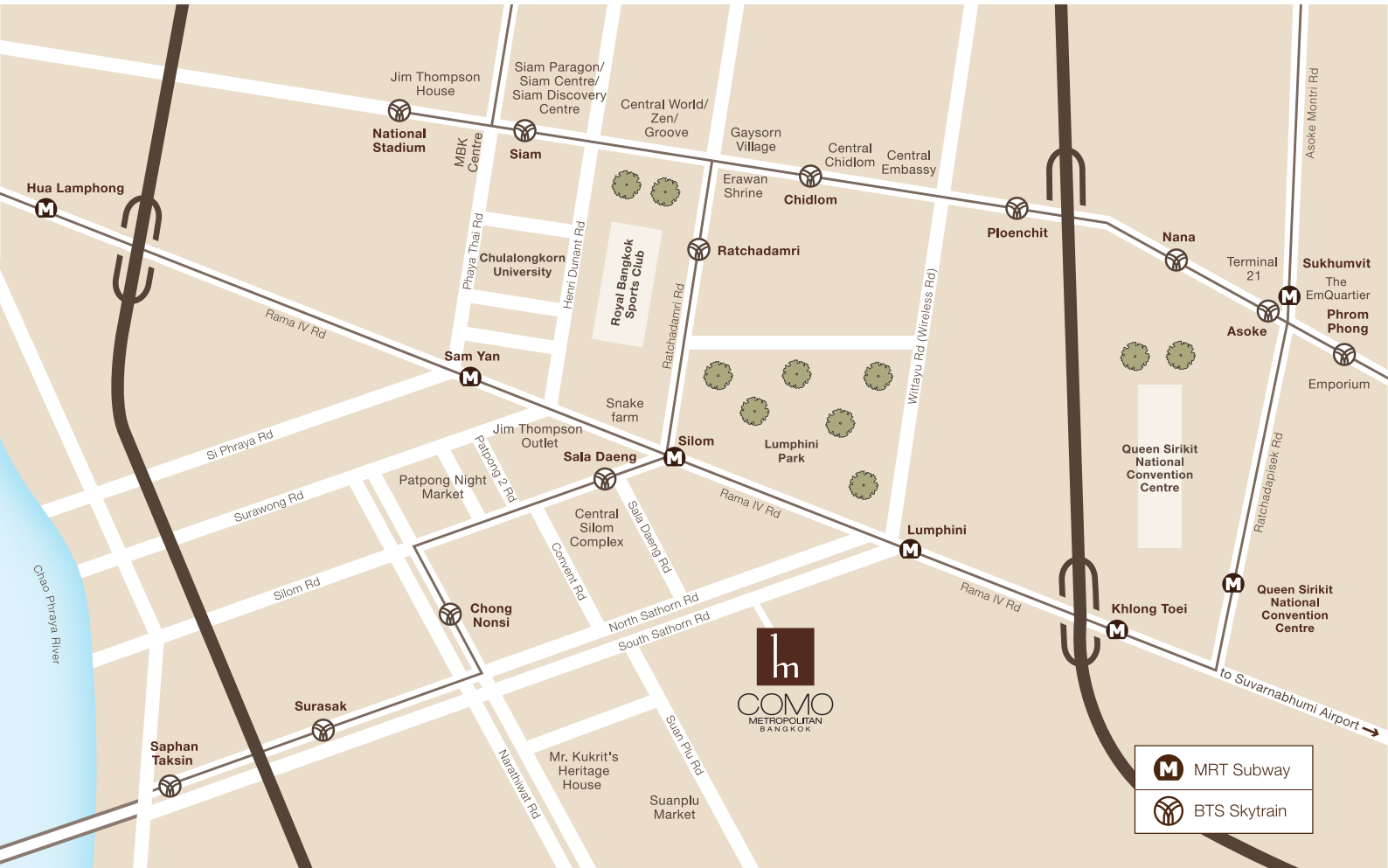

**Central Chidlom** – The flagship outlet of Central Department Store, with seven floors dedicated to shopping and dining.

**Central Embassy** – This ultra-luxe lifestyle mall has an impressive collection of fine dining, movie theatres and designer stores. Directly connected to Ploen Chit BTS Skytrain Station.

**Central Silom Complex** – A trendy shopping centre that's full of international, affordable fashion and accessories as well as a range of eateries in the basement. Steps away from Sala Daeng BTS Skytrain Station.

**Central World / Zen / Isetan** – The third-largest lifestyle mall in Bangkok, home to two department stores: Zen and Isetan. It also houses Groove, a popular gastro-ba for dining and hanging out.

**Emporium** – A six-floor shopping centre that houses well-known luxury brands alongside an expansive supermarket and food court. Conveniently accessible from Phrom Phong BTS Skytrain Station in Sukhumvit.

**Gaysorn Village** – Known for its distinctive marble and chrome design, this is a five-floor luxury shopping

complex for those looking for designer labels. Connected by skywalk to Chidlom BTS Skytrain Station in Ratchaprasong.

**MBK Centre** – A giant mall, with eight floors packed with over 2,000 shops of budget-friendly wares for a supersized shopping experience. Directly accessible from National Stadium BTS Skytrain Station.

**Patpong Night Market** – The place to bargain for your tourist fashion, souvenirs and kitsch items. A five-minute walk from Siam BTS Skytrain Station.

**Siam Paragon / Siam Centre / Siam Discovery Centre** – Siam Paragon is home to Southeast Asia's largest aquarium, a comprehensive selection of labels, cuisine and a 16-screen Cineplex. This trio of Bangkok's most popular shopping complexes is located in the heart of the city, in front of Siam BTS Skytrain Station.

**Suanplu Market** – Visited by locals searching for good quality, fresh produce, this market is the ideal place to get acquainted with Bangkok.

**Terminal 21** – A concept-mall built around famous cities – visit London, Istanbul, Tokyo, Paris and more as you make your way through each themed floor.

**The EmQuartier** – Explore over 1,000 local and international stores in this futuristic mall while enjoying zen design features such as an atrium garden and waterfall.

**Jim Thompson House** – The home of self-made American entrepreneur James H.W. Thompson who is the founder of world-renowned Thai Silk Company.

**Jim Thompson Outlet** – Home of the internationally acclaimed luxury Thai silk brand.

**Erawan Shrine** – A Hindu shrine in Bangkok, Thailand that houses a statue of Phra Phrom, the Thai representation of the Hindu god of creation, Lord Brahma.

**Lumphini Park** – The park offers the rare joy of open public spaces, trees, and playgrounds in the heart of Bangkok.

**Mr. Kukrit's Heritage House** – A heritage museum dedicated to the former Prime Minister of Thailand Kukrit Pramoj. It consists of five teak houses, the earliest of which is more than 100 years old.

**Snake Farm** – An organisation that serves to educate the public on snakes – informative, fascinating and fun.
