

KHAO PHRA TEAW NATIONAL PARK RAINFOREST HIKE

This is a challenging, four-hour trek into the green heart of Phuket's only virgin rainforest, far beyond the public access area of the Khao Phra Teaw National Park in the north of the island. The trail is inclined and slippery at times, with the occasional fallen tree to climb over or crawl under.

The hike covers eight km of rainforest full of wildlife that lives in the vegetation: wild boar, flying lemurs, langurs, gibbons and more. Then, you can take a plunge in a natural pool before beginning the descent to Phuket's biggest waterfall, Bang Pae.

For all routes, we take care of any transfers to and from COMO Point Yamu, as well as entrance fees where necessary. We also arrange for the services of a professional guide, along with refreshing beverages and nourishing snacks for the journey.

ITINERARY

8.30am Leave the resort on your transfer to Khao Phra Teaw National Park
 9.00am Arrive at Khao Phra Teaw National Park starting from Ton Sai Waterfall
 12.00pm Visit at Bang Pae Waterfall

- Prices are subject to 10 per cent service charge and seven per cent government tax
- Reservations must be made at least a day in advance at COMO Point Yamu
- Cancellation must be made at least a day in advance at COMO Point Yamu; for cancellations made within 24 hours, a cancellation charge of 50 per cent applies
- In the event of bad weather, a cancellation call will be made to your room between 6.00am and 6.30am on the excursion day
- Timings of the itinerary are approximate, dependent on the participants' walking abilities and weather conditions
