### RAFTING ON THE AYUNG RIVER

Float down the Ayung River, through Bali's stunning natural flora, keeping an eye out for the local wildlife. The rapids provide an exhilarating thrill whilst experienced river guides ensure rafters' complete safety at all times. The route also passes by COMO Uma Ubud's sister property, COMO Shambhala Estate.

### ATV TOURS

Ride a quad or buggy through untamed jungles, villages and plantations, taking in Bali's less travelled side. This ATV tour is 5km long and takes you uphill and downhill through jungle, mud, rice paddies, rivers and more. You'll be accompanied by a professional guide who will conduct safety briefings about the vehicle and route.

### JUNGLE TREK AND CANOEING TOUR

Starting your journey at Candi Kesuma village, explore the beautiful flora and fauna of a native rainforest, surrounded by the high peaks of Bali's sacred mountains. An expert local guide will take you on an informative journey, explaining the geography and history of your surroundings. Merging the natural world with the spiritual, discover sacred temples built by Hindu and Buddhist missionaries within the rural forest. After finishing your jungle trek, return to the village by canoe, across the tranquil waters of Lake Tamblingan. Before you head back to COMO Uma Ubud, stop off at the botanical garden in Bedugul, where you can stroll through the orchid house, cactus garden and specially cultivated herb plantation. There are other optional extras which you can discuss with your guide, such as a visit to Ulun Danu temple, or lunch at a lakeside restaurant.

### TJAMPUHAN RIDGE AND TEMPLE WALK

Travel along the ancient Tjampuhan Ridge – a relaxed and tranquil vista high above Ubud – to Tjampuhan Temple, where locals make offerings to Bali's gods. The walk ends at the foot of the Tjampuhan Bridge, a sacred junction point in the River Oos. Along the way you will stop at art galleries and terraced rice paddies, where you can take in the emerald views of palm and coconut trees and the rustling along-which line the ridge.

### MOUNT BATUR SUNRISE TREKKING

### BEDUGUL HIGHLAND AND MARKETS TOUR

Following a morning exploring the local market and a visit to the Kebun Raya Botanical Gardens – whose orchid house is a particular highlight – this tour will take you up into the cool mountain air to find the isolated lake temple of Ulun Danu. Dedicated to Dewi Danu, the goddess of the lake, the temple is a place few tourists get to visit. The return leg includes a stop for lunch at a local restaurant recommended by your guide, before continuing on to Taman Ayun temple, the largest royal temple in Bali, set in immaculately tended traditional gardens.

### WATER PURIFICATION CEREMONY AT TIRTA EMPUL

Take part in a traditional Balinese purification ceremony at the historic Tirta Empul temple in northeast Ubud. Your guide will take you through every step of the Hindu purification ceremony in this 1000-year-old temple including the making and presentation of offerings, the saying of traditional prayers, dressing in temple attire and partaking in the holy water rituals.

### PURIFICATION CEREMONY AT SEBATU HOLY SPRING

With the help of your guide, experience the Balinese-Hindu ritual of 'Melukat', or ritual purification, at Sebatu holy spring – located near two ancient temples: Dalem Pingit and Kusti temple. Hindus see the ritual as a literal cleansing of the body and a symbolic cleansing of the soul, aimed at preventing misfortune and sicknesses. Twenty-five minutes north of Ubud, Sebatu is one known as one of the most ancient and holy places in Bali for spiritual purification.

### KINTAMANI VOLCANOES AND TEMPLES TOUR

This day-long excursion takes you to a number of ancient temples located across Mount Batur's smoldering — but completely safe — upper slopes. Chief among them is Goa Gajah — known popularly as the Elephant Cave temple — which leads to the bubbling waters of Tirta Empul, the Holy Spring temple. You also have the chance to explore an agri-tourism park, where you can sample products made from locally grown chocolate, coffee and vanilla. With a choice of places to stop for lunch, in Kintamani or near Tirta Empul Temple, the tour culminates in a winding downhill drive looking out over the crater at Mount Batur and then the terraced rice fields of Ceking in Tegalalang.

### UMA COOKERY CLASS

Held in our Kemiri restaurant and hosted by COMO Uma Ubud's chef, this experience provides an insight into many areas of Balinese life and culture. Working with exotic herbs and spices native to the Ubud area, you can learn how to prepare a traditional Indonesian meal, one of COMO Uma Ubud's signature Southeast Asian dishes, or something from COMO Shambhala's health-focused menu. The session aims to start by 11.00am so that the meals can be sampled over lunch.
