

Diving Information

Diving in the Maldives is an amazing experience, so to ensure your enjoyment, comfort and safety, we kindly ask you to read the following information.

COMO Maalifushi's Marine Sports Centre requires all divers to hold an international SCUBA diving license and we ask you to show this, along with your logbook, at the Marine Sports Centre before diving. You may have to partake in an orientation dive on the house reef as part of Maldivian diving regulations.

Other Maldivian regulations include:

1. No dive deeper than 30 metres
2. All dives are to be no decompression dives
3. Open water divers or CMAS 1 star are limited to 20m

Many of the dives in the Maldives involve currents and drift dives, so please listen to the advice and instructions of the guides, and dive within your limitations. We want you to enjoy your dives safely.

General

COMO Maalifushi's Marine Sports Centre hours are from 8.00am to 6.00pm and closed for lunch between 12.30pm to 1.30pm. For added safety, we ask all divers to have 24 hours between the last dive and flying. We provide a basket for you to keep your diving and personal equipment in while diving with us. During this time we will take the utmost care of your equipment, but hold no responsibility for loss or damage. Please do not leave valuables in the basket; instead hand them into the Marine Sports Centre or please leave them in your room. Dive baskets and wetsuits are locked away at night. Wash tank and showers are available for washing of equipment.

Orientation Dive

Conducted at 10.00am everyday or upon availability and request. All divers require an orientation dive, unless you have proof you have been diving within the last three months. The orientation dive consists of a dive on the house reef, with an instructor/guide, who will get you to demonstrate these skills:

1. Regulator recovery and clear
2. Mask clearing
3. Alternate air source breathing

After completing these skills, you will be guided around the dive site, being shown the interesting marine life and topography.



Activities

Diving Reservations

These can be made at the Marine Sports Centre reception, before 5.30pm the day before the scheduled dive. We provide a description and dive map of each dive site to help you with your reservations.

If you are unsure whether you will dive the next day, we recommend you proceed with pre-booking your dive ahead of time. This will allow us to make the necessary preparations and will ensure you avoid disappointment should the boat or diving schedule be full. For cancellation, please contact the Marine Sports Centre before the time of departure. We do not charge for cancellation.

Weekly Diving Schedule

For a copy of the weekly diving schedule, please contact the Marine Sports Centre. Boat dives take place every day at 8.00am, 10:00am and 2.00pm. The 8.00am dive is generally reserved for experienced divers – however this is dependent upon how many divers we have in-house.

For guests who are not yet certified, and for guests who are certified but diving at COMO Maalifushi for the first time, we offer a house reef dive.

Charges

All services are subject to a 10 per cent service charge and prevailing government taxes.

Diving Sites

With around 25 local dive sites, you will have many options to choose from, so please see the descriptions of the dive sites or ask our diving staff for recommendations. We endeavour to match up diving ability to local dive conditions to ensure your safety and enjoyment.

Diving Options

We offer three boat dives everyday upon availability. Two house reef dives per day, opportunities for half and full day diving trips by speedboat, night diving and a full range of PADI diving courses from first experience through to certification courses. A lot of the courses are now able to be conducted via e-learning, through the PADI website. To increase learning flexibility and maximise your diving experiences while at COMO Maalifushi, you can complete your theory in the comfort of your own home.

Boat Diving

We have approximately 25 dive sites including our one-day safaris around the atoll with travel time ranging from 10 minutes to 45 minutes. We endeavour to cater for all levels and experience, with safety and enjoyment our most important priorities. If you have any questions please ask our helpful instructors. We ask you to be at the Marine Sports Centre 15 minutes before the dive time to give sufficient time for equipment inspection and pre-dive briefing. Our dives are conducted mainly from a locally made boat called a Dhoni, which provides a pleasant, relaxed atmosphere during the journey to and from the dive sites.

Time: 8.00am, 10:00am or 2.00pm

Nitrox Diving

On request, we arrange complimentary nitrox dives for certified enriched air divers. If you are not certified yet, but would like to try, we can offer a Nitrox Introduction Dive or a Nitrox Diver Course. Please contact the Marine Sports Centre staff for further information.

If you choose to go house reef diving, we require you to join our Orientation Dive led by an instructor.

Half and Full Day Diving Excursions

Explore COMO Maalifushi's Thaa Atoll and the neighbouring Meemu and Laamu Atolls on our comfortable speedboat: Atoll Wanderer. Atoll Wanderer can be chartered privately, or you can embark on a trip with other guests to enjoy a two- or three-dive excursion around the Maldivian reefs. It is also possible to charter our dhoni boat – perfect for shorter trips and larger groups of guests who wish to explore the Thaa Atoll sites at a more leisurely pace, in a more spacious vessel.

Night Diving

Night dives are conducted three days a week or on request. Please make a reservation at the Marine Sports Centre. A surcharge of US\$15 will be applied for night diving, which includes torch rental.

Time: 6.30pm – 7.30pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday (or on request)

UV Night Fluoro Diving

Night fluoro diving is a new experience, where you will see coral in an amazing new light. Book a night fluoro dive at the Marine Sports Centre to experience it first-hand. A surcharge of US\$40 will be applied for fluoro night diving, which includes a torch and special lens rental.

For those who have never fly fished before or for those that want to improve their fly fishing ability, our guide can help you with private lessons.

Charges

All services are subject to a 10 per cent service charge and prevailing government taxes.

Weather Conditions and Cancellations

If the weather is deemed unsafe, the charter will be rescheduled. If this is not possible to arrange, no charge will occur. Cancellations made less than four hours prior to the charter booking will incur a 100 per cent cancellation fee. Light spin tackle may be used if conditions are too windy for fly fishing.

Sustainability

At COMO Hotels and Resorts, we are mindful of our impact on the cultures, economies and environments in which we operate. We invite you to join your fellow guests at COMO Maalifushi in learning about and participating in our sustainability initiatives.

Biodiversity Conservation

In the pristine Thaa Atoll, we are privileged to be among some 180 species of coral, 1,100 species of fish, 23 species of marine mammals and two species of sea turtles. COMO Maalifushi is committed to conserving this rich marine biodiversity through education, monitoring, cleaning and careful coral propagation. COMO Maalifushi partners with the Marine Research Centre to monitor marine life and catalogue ocean debris, and has received the PADI Green Star Award, which signifies a responsible dive centre which has demonstrated a dedication to conservation. You are warmly invited to attend our weekly marine presentation by our resident marine biologist at Thila, on Tuesdays at 7.00pm, to learn about the marine life on the house reef around COMO Maalifushi.

We ask you not to feed the fish, rays and marine animals. Bread and cookies are especially indigestible to fish, and any leftover processed foods in the water can cause excessive algae growth that is damaging to coral. You may join our marine life presentation, with fish-feeding, on Sunday at 6.30pm at Tai.

The coral that surrounds us comprise colonies of very small living organisms that take hundreds of years to form and build the reef structure. We ask you not to touch, walk or stand on coral, which can damage and hurt the living coral polyps.

In an effort to reverse the coral bleaching by El Nino in 1998 and in 2016, we also partner with Seamarc in a careful coral propagation programme. You can be part of this programme by installing a coral reef frame with our Resident Marine Biologist. As the coral grows, marine life flourishes. You will be able to monitor its progress every six months by getting updates from our Marine Sports Centre team, or by revisiting the frame upon your return. This project also enjoys a secondary benefit of providing livelihood opportunities for communities in the Baa Atoll, where the frames are locally made.

Sustainable Sourcing

COMO Maalifushi's Executive Chef and our kitchen team draw from our own organic kitchen garden for the vegetables and herbs in your meals. The organic garden is located in the heart of the island, and is nourished by shredded green waste from landscaping. No chemical fertilisers or pesticides are used in our garden or on our island.

Resource Conservation

COMO Maalifushi is equipped with high-efficiency water heaters, kitchen equipment, energy-efficient toilets, as well as faucets and showerheads that conserve energy and water while ensuring optimum comfort for you. We generate our own water and power at COMO Maalifushi and we appreciate your partnership in conserving these precious resources by turning off taps when not in use and switching off the air conditioner if you prefer to open the balcony doors for extended periods.

We seek to reduce our carbon footprint wherever possible: 15 per cent of all of the energy we use at COMO Maalifushi is generated by our own solar panels, and we also provide environmentally-friendly transport options, such as bicycles, tricycles and rechargeable electric buggies, to help you explore the island.

Your room is serviced twice a day and your bed linens will be changed every other day. If you prefer them changed more frequently, simply advise the Guest Services team. We also invite you to join your fellow guests in hanging any towels you wish to reuse.

Drinking Water

At COMO Maalifushi, we are committed to providing you the best possible island experience while minimising our impact on the environment. To this end, we produce our own potable water onsite for your safety and enjoyment through reverse osmosis and desalination processes to World Health Organisation (WHO) standards. All tap water at COMO Maalifushi is thus safe to drink. To reduce plastic waste, our water purification and bottling system produces high-quality, low-impact still and sparkling water in reusable sterilised glass bottles, which are stocked in your room and served at the restaurants.

Waste Management

To minimise our impact on the COMO Maalifushi, we appreciate your help in separating your waste. Please leave the fruit skins on the fruit plates, which our housekeeping team will clear for composting for our vegetable gardens.

Community

As the pioneer resort in the Thaa Atoll, we take great pride in providing livelihood opportunities to the local community. The nearest island to COMO Maalifushi is Guraidhoo, where fishing has been the main source of income for generations. COMO Maalifushi has worked closely with the Guraidhoo local council to provide internships to local youth interested in pursuing careers in the hospitality sector as an alternative to fishing. For local secondary school students interested in careers as dive masters or marine conservationists, COMO Maalifushi also sponsors their open-water diving certification.

To respect the culture and tradition of the Maldives, we request that guests dress modestly, covering the shoulders and knees when visiting local islands. In accordance with local law, please refrain from nude or topless sunbathing at the resort and while on excursions.



Social Responsibility

Despite a heady combination of good climate, white sand and warm seas, tourism developments in the Maldives have been sensibly controlled during years of peaceful Islamic governance, displaying respect for the region's inimitable culture and natural resources.

The Maldivians are predominantly Muslim. To respect their culture, we advise everyone to wear modest clothing covering the shoulders and knees when visiting other local islands. Nudity and topless sunbathing is strictly prohibited at the resort and while on excursions.

The Maldives is known to be one of the best snorkelling and diving destinations in the world. It is our role to maintain this pristine beauty by not throwing any litter into the sea and to dispose of waste and garbage in the receptors provided.

To preserve the culture and tradition of Maldives, net fishing is prohibited by law. Fishing of any kind inside the house reef and around COMO Maalifushi is also not permitted. Please support our campaign of conserving the natural resources by not buying products made out of sharks, turtles, corals and the like. Do not remove shells or conches, as this is prohibited by law for certain species.



Safety

Evacuation

At COMO Maalifushi, your safety is our greatest concern. Please take a few moments to familiarise yourself with the nearest fire exits and meeting points. There are two different assembly points; one in front of the swimming pool, the other near Tai Beach. Prominent exits will guide you to safety.

In the event of an emergency requiring you to evacuate the hotel, take your room key, in-room life jacket and travel documents, and exit the room. Apart from this do not stop to collect any other personal belongings. If at night, wear outdoor shoes and a coat for warmth and protection. Do not wear slippers.

If you detect a fire, or if the fire alarm goes off, you should immediately leave the building.

Feel the door with the back of your hand; if it is hot, do not open it and stay in the room to await assistance. If not, open it slowly, but be ready to close it quickly if necessary.

If there is smoke in your room when you are in bed, roll off the mattress onto the floor and crawl to the door. Don't stand, as smoke and deadly gases rise. If time allows, go to the bathroom, collect a towel, make it wet and place it over your face to act as an air filter to help you to breathe.

After exiting, close your room door to help stop the smoke or fire from spreading, and to protect your belongings.

Report to the Assembly Point advised by the Guest Service Team (there are two different assembly points; one in front of the swimming pool, the other near Tai Beach). Please do not re-enter any building until told it is safe to do so.

Rest assured, all COMO Maalifushi staff regularly undergo training for emergencies, including firefighting.

Smoke and heat detectors are located in all bedrooms, corridors, public areas, offices and facilities. The automatic fire alarm system, supplemented by a manual alarm, includes alarm bells in all areas of the resort.

Portable fire extinguishers are also provided in every room, all facilities and public areas. In a fire situation, these are the first tools for firefighting.



Safety

Pool Safety

The swimming pools at COMO Maalifushi are not suitable for diving. Please follow all specific safety signs in the recreational and public areas and listen to safety instructions given.

Safe Snorkelling

Complimentary usage of snorkelling equipment is available at the Marine Sports Centre. When snorkelling, be aware of currents in the water and practice safe swimming by wearing a life jacket, even if you are a capable swimmer. You should always ensure someone knows where you are snorkelling, and your return time. We provide detailed briefings on safety as well as snorkelling locations upon issuing you with masks and fins.
